After months of meetings and negotiations, the “Donation Agreement” between the Town of Greenburgh and Paws Crossed Animal Rescue Inc. (PCAR) has been signed enabling the transfer of the dormant animal shelter located at 100 Warehouse Lane South in Elmsford. The Closing Date on this property will be announced next week.

“Paws Crossed could not be more excited and happy! We are so grateful to the Town of Greenburgh, our wonderful lawyer, and of course for our outstanding community who have shown true patience, endurance and continuous support throughout this entire process. It is now time for all of us to focus our attention on the future and our rescue mission” says Jennifer Angelucci, President/CEO of Paws Crossed Animal Rescue Inc.

After the Closing is complete, the next step will be to get our engineers into the building and have them map out a blueprint of the portions that are deemed **immediately** safe and operational. The building will be prepared so that those areas can be used while the damaged areas are being renovated. Then, through a detailed timeline and a strategic Capital Campaign, life will be rejuvenated back into this damaged structure... one section at a time. The first phase, of this projected 2-3 year project, will be called **CHAPTER ONE: Moving In and Preparing a Home for the Animals...** we hope to bring “home” the Westchester Legacy animals and provide much needed rescue efforts.

Next steps, timelines and monetary amounts needed for each CHAPTER will depend on the engineers’ evaluation and recommendations. PCAR will be documenting and sharing each step along the way, for both transparency and posterity sake. We want to **THANK YOU** for remaining with PCAR all these months and keeping this story in the public eye...we hope that you will continue to participate in the writing of what is going to be an amazing book at the completion of all these chapters!
